

- Prepare a demonstration of conducting to a recording of your choosing. Demonstrate pattern legibility, tempo control, que's, dynamics, and overall presence.

	Choose one of the following questions to answer in essay format: - Why do I want to be part of the 22-23 MBOP Leadership Team?
	- What is an area of the MBOP/Band/Guard program that needs improvement and what can I/will I do to make it better?
	Interview someone on campus (student, faculty, or administrator) not affiliated with band and ask them for views on leadership. What did you learn from your conversation? How is it different from yours? Prepare a synopsis explaining what you learned in this process.
	Complete a service project for MBOP/Band/Guard. The scope and duration of the project are at your discretion. You may choose something that you think needs to be done, or you may ask the directors for a project. If you have any questions about the validity of your chosen project, please speak with the directors prior to starting it. Creativity is key in this component. Be prepared to present about your <b>COMPLETED</b> project during your audition interview on May 16 <sup>th</sup> .
