Audition Week Information

<u>Open House Dates:</u> May 4th – May 6th (Monday – Wednesday)

Open House rehearsals will be filmed online. All skills

will be taught over the course of the 3 days.

Audition: Thursday, May 7th 5:00pm (Videos must be submitted)

<u>Where:</u> Schoology Online Learning Group (FGM3-54C8-PCPNQ)

Attire: Any form fitting dance clothes or workout attire, dance shoes or lightweight sneakers. NO JEANS, SANDALS, OR JEWELRY!
On audition day you must wear all black with hair and make-up done for a performance.

What to Expect: During open house rehearsals we will do a quick warm-up stretch, then begin rehearsal. Students will work on dance basics and learn a few across the floor sequences. A short contemporary dance piece will be learned for auditions using elements of ballet, hip-hop, jazz, and modern. A few flag basics will be explained and taught, then a short flag phrase. Elements will continue to be added over the course of the 3-day Open House. You will not need to have any choreography prepared.

<u>Spectators:</u> Rehearsals and Auditions are closed to the public. No

one other than candidates, staff, and judges will be

allowed into the rehearsal/audition space.

<u>Paperwork:</u> All forms need to be turned in by 8:00pm Wednesday,

May 6th. This includes: Application, Financial Agreement Form, and a copy of your last Report

Card.

IF YOU MAKE THE TEAM!

<u>Commitment:</u> Members of the 2020-2021 BRHS Colorguard will be obligated to perform for one entire school year. This includes both Fall Marching Band and Winter Colorguard. Students will be placed in either Varsity or JV Winterguard at the director's discretion, based on their talent and performance levels.

<u>Colorguard Constitution:</u> Upon making the 2020-2021 BRHS Colorguard, each team member (and their parent/legal guardian) will be required to sign the team constitution.

<u>Guard Class:</u> All members are required to take Colorguard Class as an elective. This class will be used to teach technique on Flag, Rifle, and Sabre. It will also be a comprehensive dance technique class.

<u>Practice Schedule:</u> The 2020-2021 school year is divided into 2 different seasons for colorguard. From May-November is considered Fall Guard (MBOP Guard) and December-April is considered Winter Guard (the Braden River Visual Ensemble). ALL MEMBERS will perform as members of both groups.

During Fall Guard, weekly rehearsals are Tuesday and Thursday evening from 4:00pm-8:00pm with the Marching Band. There will also be Monday Colorguard sectionals from 2:45pm-4:00pm.

During Winter Guard, Varsity evening rehearsals will be held on Tuesday and Thursday from 4:00pm-8:00pm. JV rehearsals will be held Monday and Friday 4:30pm-8:00pm.

<u>Uniforms/Equipment:</u> Official Uniforms and Show Equipment are supplied by the Band Department and are property of Braden River High School. All members are required to purchase their own shoes, warm-ups, duffle bags, flag bags, and home practice flags. (All are ordered through the Colorguard and the Braden River Band Boosters and are included with Band/Guard fees)

<u>Fundraisers:</u> There will be several optional opportunities for members to fund raise their membership dues. There will also be a few MANDITORY FUNDRAISERS that are required to assist the program. ALL GUARD MEMBERS will be required to participate in these fundraisers.

<u>Guard Camp</u>: ALL GUARD MEMBERS must attend Guard Camp this summer. Failure to attend will result in dismissal from the group.

<u>Times:</u> 9:00am - 5:00pm

Where: Braden River High School

<u>Band Camp:</u> Colorguard members are considered members of The Braden River Marching Band of Pirates and must also abide by the same rules as band members. This means that participation in the season requires that ALL GUARD MEMBERS must attend Band Camp.

Dates: July 20th -24th and July 27th- 31st

<u>Winter Guard Camps:</u> There will be 2 weekend camps per colorguard (Friday Evening/Saturday) in December/January that will be used to stage and learn choreography for the indoor show. These dates will be announced in late October.

<u>Insurance/Medical Sports Physical Requirements:</u> ALL GUARD MEMBERS are required to purchase the basic school medical insurance (\$50) and complete a medical sports physical and evaluation before ANY participation in school related activities. This is a Manatee County School Board Policy!

Cost of 2019 Participation = \$1,200

Discounts:

\$100 off - Volunteer Credit: Must work 30 hours during Marching Band Season

(These are NOT the same hours your student may work to earn for community service hours for the Bright Futures scholarship awards)

\$250 off – Siblings (First student full price, second student \$950)

(Discounts may be combined)

Payments:

- We take Cash, Check, or Credit Card via PayPal

 - o Fees can be divided into 6 payments + deposit
 - o All payments must be complete by November 12th 2019

Refund Policy:

\$100 of the \$200 deposit is nonrefundable. If a student decides not to continue participation in Marching Band before July 1st, a refund will be provided. The refund amount is dependent on materials bought for that MBOP member up to that point. Costs associated with t-shirts, gloves, hats, Color Guard uniform, tights, shoes, etc., will be deducted from the refund. No refunds will be given after the July 1st deadline.

Guard Uniform:

Color Guard uniforms are custom made for each individual guard member. Uniforms are generally ordered early summer. <u>At least \$400 in fees will need to be paid BEFORE the guard uniform is ordered.</u> (If the Payment schedule is followed this will not be a problem) Uniforms take six weeks to make. Therefore, if the fees are not received and the uniform cannot be purchased, the color guard member may not be able to participate in the competitive portion of marching band. All fees must be paid before winter guard uniforms are ordered. All guard uniforms are the property of BRBBA.

Participation Policy:

If a student's account has a balance from the previous marching season, they will not be allowed to register for the new season. If a student's account becomes delinquent, they will be pulled from practice and performance opportunities. Students are still required to attend all dates on the official rehearsal and performance calendar.

Fund Raising Policy:

The Band Booster Association tries to organize several fundraisers over the course of the year. For certain fundraisers, money raised by an individual student may go towards that individual student's band and trip fees.

Financial-Aid:

Only a limited amount of financial-aid is available every season. Students must qualify and submit an application to receive financial-aid. Any financial-aid that is given will go towards that student's unpaid band fees. Financial-aid cannot be redeemed for cash.

Invoice for Fees for Color Guard Members

Families have two options to pay fees: one payment of total fees or installment payments. Installment payments require a down payment of at least \$200 at sign up and all fees must be paid in full by September 1st, 2020. Families also have an opportunity to reduce the band fees by \$100 by completing a total of 30 hours (per student enrolled) of volunteer time with the marching band including concession stand.
